In-Kind Donations for Refugees in Calais and Dunkirk

The local-based charity 'People in Motion' has requested in-kind donations to help refugees in France following destruction of the Dunkirk refugee camp. The young men from that camp are now completely homeless in France and are being harassed by the local French police so they have been returning to Calais. The urgent requirements are for blankets, sleeping bags, dark hoodies, dark jogging pants, clean-as-new underwear, and toiletries (but not bubble bath, shampoo or shower gel)

The Charity will provide a labelled donation bin in the church and will ensure that it is emptied regularly (for example weekly) and items will be passed forward to the refugees.
